

2010-2011 Devilray All Stars Tryout Packet

Thank you for your time and interest in the Devilray All Star Program. We are very interested in your child being a part of our program and know that each child is special to us here at Devilrays. Over the years we feel like the first questions people ask us are, "How much does it cost to be a Devilray?" and "What is the time commitment?" The following should help answer these questions.

How Much Does It Cost?

The monthly fee for All Stars will range from \$260 to \$280 a month. This year we have consolidated the payment for All Stars into one payment per month. There will be **NO SEPARATE BOOSTER PAYMENT** this year. The payment is due on the 1st of each month and should be made out to Devilray Cheer. Payments will be from May to February with March being free. The payment will vary depending on what tumbling class you are required to take. The break down is as follows:

\$ 140.00	*Booster (Roughly \$1,000 Entry Fees and Coaches Fees, \$300 Choreography, \$100 Booster)
\$ 70.00	All Star Practices
<u>\$ 50 to 70</u>	Tumbling Class
\$260-280	Total Monthly Dues

Each All Star will be required to make sure they have a uniform and a pair of Infinity Passion shoes. The Infinity Passion shoes can be purchased through us or you can find them online. You may want to buy a used uniform or be fitted for a new one. The cost of used uniform varies and the cost of a new one is \$250.00. The uniform swap and fitting will be on June 12th.

How Much Time Is Required?

Each All Star is required to be at the gym approximately 5 to 6 hours during the week. The break down is as follows: (1) 1 to 2 hour tumbling class and (2) 2 hour squad practices. Since the Devilray Program is a competitive program, each team is evaluated on a regular basis and practices may increase if needed, but the coach or owner will make sure that the parents are informed of such additions. It is our job to make sure that your child looks and performs at the most optimal level.

If I Am Interested in Devilrays What Do I Do Now?

Each All Star Parent will need to read the following pages, separate the forms that need to be signed, make a copy of their child's birth certificate, bring their \$50 tryout fee, and turn them in by April 17, 2010. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to contact either:

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

In consideration of the service of Devilray Cheer Company LLC, its owners, agents, officers, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "DCC"). I hereby agree to release, discharge, and hold harmless DCC, on behalf of myself, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follow:

- 1. I understand and acknowledge that the activities that I or my child engage in while on the premises or under the auspices of DCC pose known and unknown risk which could result in injury, paralysis, death, emotional distress, or damage to me, my child, to property, or to third parties. The following describes some, but not all, of those risks.

Cheerleading and gymnastics, including performances of stunts and use of trampolines, entail certain risks that simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. Without a certain degree of risk, cheerleading students would not improve their skills and the enjoyment of the sport would be diminished. Cheerleading and gymnastics expose participants to the usual risk of cuts and bruises and other more serious risks as well. Participants often fall, sprain or break wrists and ankles, and can suffer more serious injuries. Traveling to and from shows, meets, and exhibitions raises the possibilities of any manner of transportation accidents. In any event, if you or your child is injured, medical assistance may be required which you must pay for yourself.

- 2. I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks, known and unknown, connected with DCC related activities, including but not limited to performance of stunts and use of trampolines. My participation and that of my child is purely voluntary. No one has forced or coerced me or my child to participate. I elect for myself and children to participate in such activities in spite of the risks.

- 3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to hold harmless and indemnify DCC from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions or rights of action, which are related to arise out of, or are in any way connected with my child's participation in DCC related activities.

- 4. Should DCC be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and reimburse them for such fees and costs.

- 5. I certify that my child has health, accident and liability insurance to cover bodily injury or Property damage that may be caused or suffered while participating in this event or activity, or else I agree to bear the cost of such injury or damage to my child. I further certify that I am willing to assume the risks that may arise or be created, directly or indirectly, through or by any such condition.

- 6. In the event that I file lawsuit against DCC, I agree to do so solely in the State of Georgia and I further agree that the substantive and procedural laws in the state shall apply in any such action without regard to the conflict of laws rules thereof. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

- 7. By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my participation of any of my children in this activity, I may be found by court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against DCC on the basis of any claim from which I have released DCC by signing this agreement.

I have had sufficient opportunity to read this entire document. I have read it and understand it. I agree to be bound to its terms.

Policies and Expectations General Information

- If you ever have a problem with anything, please do not hesitate to contact the gym, your coach, or gym manager/owner. We are here for YOU.
- If you have any questions or concerns that need immediate attention please use the following chain of command:
1) Team Mom 2) Head Coach 3) Owner
- NO GOSSIP about any other teams (all star or school). NO GOSSIP about a child on your team or another team. NO GOSSIP about coaches and staff. It is much better to address a problem than to listen to idle gossip.
- Please feel free to talk to your coach about anything; just remember to do it at the appropriate times. For example, approaching a coach in the middle of a practice would not be an appropriate time.
- No profanity or abusive language.
- During practice your opinion does not count. All squad and routine decisions are left to the discretion of the coaches.
- Please keep in mind the gym is not a babysitting service. We want our all stars to use the gym as often possible, but children should not be dropped off at the gym unsupervised.
- Every year we go through losses and additions of team members. The dismissal/addition of a team member is solely the coach's decision.
- Never post any negative comments on any websites or chat rooms.
- Practices may be changed or added at any time during the season.
- Anyone threatening to quit or to pull their child from a squad will be dismissed from the program immediately.
- Please do not take valuables to the gym; we are not responsible for unattended items.
- It is the parent's responsibility to know what is going on with your squad. Check your emails and the website regularly.
- The coaches reserve the right to close practices at ANY time for ANY reason. In this event, the team rep will remain at practices.
- Only cheerleaders and coaches are allowed in the gym.
- No one is allowed to yell on to the floor or try to make contact through the parent viewing area window during practices or tumble classes. This is extremely distracting to all involved.
- Withholding a child from a practice or a competition should never be used as a form of punishment. You are not only punishing your child but every other team member and parent on that squad.
- We will do our best to work with your extracurricular activities. However, if the other coach refuses to work with our mandatory practices or competitions, you may have to make a choice.
- Each team will be assigned teams to watch at competitions. We would love to have everyone there all day, but at the very least, you are obligated to watch your assigned teams.
- Parents, relatives, friends and cheerleaders are never allowed to speak with competition officials for any reason.
- Parents are NEVER allowed to represent Devilray All Stars or Devilray Cheer Company under any circumstances concerning accommodations, competitions or any other situation.
- All Devilray cheerleaders and Devilray family/friends will show good sportsmanship at all times.
- There will be no arguing or questioning of the coaching staff's decisions at competitions.
- The Gym Owner may change, add or subtract any rule at any time.

GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP, POLITE MANNERS AND A KIND DISPOSITION ARE MANDATORY AT ALL COMPETITIONS AND PRACTICES. THIS PROGRAM PRIDES ITSELF ON SETTING A HIGH STANDARD OF BEHAVIOR. PLEASE HELP US TO CONTINUE IN THIS ENDEAVOR.

Tardiness

- You are considered tardy to practice if you are not on the practice floor ready to practice when your practice BEGINS. This means appropriate practice wear on, shoes on and tied, hair up, snacks and drinks taken care of, ready to go.

Absences

All Star cheerleading is the equivalent of a “travel” baseball/softball team or an “all star” volleyball or soccer team. We expect 100% dedication to your team. That means attendance is mandatory.

Excused Absences include:

- A school function that results in a grade for that class.
- A death in the family
- A contagious sickness, but you must first talk with your coach.

Unexcused Absences include, but are not exclusive to:

- Jobs
- Dances, birthday parties, concerts, banquets, family reunions, weddings, etc.
- School projects and homework.

There are precious few hours that we have these teams together; every moment must be used. It is extremely important you get to practice on time, and try not to miss. Excessive tardiness or absences will result in dismissal from your team. If you are tardy or absent from a competition you will be *immediately* dismissed. Also, you must attend practice if you are sick and not contagious. Let your coach know what is going on, but your presence will be needed at every practice.

After August 4th practices are mandatory. Absences will not be allowed during the week leading up to a National competition (no exceptions). We cannot stress how important your attendance is; there is choreography, stunting, and formations, etc taught at every practice. If you miss that information, you hold the entire team back.

Injuries and Conditioning

- Parents need to note that cheerleading is a highly competitive and dangerous sport. The stunts and tumbling could lead to injuries. These include but are not limited to bruises, pulled or strained muscles, torn or strained ligaments, broken bones, dislocations, paralysis, or even death. We at Devilray Cheer Company take every precaution to limit these injuries. Unfortunately, we cannot prevent them all. In the event that your child is injured we will take every necessary step to ensure your child’s well being.
- All Star Cheerleading is a very strenuous sport. Therefore, all of the athletes in our program are expected to be in top physical condition. This includes flexibility, strength, and endurance. If needed, you may be required to take an additional tumble class or a stretch/stunt class. All extra classes will be billed to your Devilray Cheer Company account.
- All team members are expected to take care of their bodies. This means absolutely NO DRUGS, NO ALCOHOL AND NO TOBACCO. If anyone is caught drinking, smoking or using drugs, or if there is an eating disorder they will be expected to take the necessary steps to quit and/or receive help. We will, of course, help in any way we can.

Travel

- When we travel out of state for competitions, the gym will block rooms off at a hotel. Once those rooms are blocked parents will need to call the hotel and book their reservation. The hotel will only hold the rooms for so long. Parents will need to make sure they book their reservations before the set date to ensure they have a room.
- Each cheerleader must have a chaperone at every competition. It is not your coach, Team Rep or Devilray staff's responsibility to be your child's chaperone.
- It is your responsibility to pay the hotel directly for your room.
- Proper traveling attire will be discussed with each team prior to an out of town competition.
- If a person decides to not stay where the gym chooses to stay, that person needs to be able to meet the team wherever the team is planning to meet. Please check with your coach to find out where they plan to meet ahead of time.

Dress Code

- No sports bras only. Sports bras should always be worn under t-shirts or tank tops. Please, no bra straps showing. We have a predominately male staff that has no need to see the girl's undergarments. Parents, please help enforce this rule!
- If your child is a flyer or is taking a stretch or stunt class, they should always wear bloomers or tight fitting shorts under a regular pair of shorts.
- All cell phones must be left outside of practice area.
- **NO JEWELRY AT ALL!** Wearing jewelry of any kind could result in an injury to your child or to another child.
- Fingernails need to be kept short, please no fake fingernails.

Competition Dress Code

- You may wear your uniform top, black pants with bloomers under pants to arrive at a competition.
- Carry your skirt in your bag or on a hanger until you put it on.
- At any time should a skirt be worn over your pants.
- You may wear your Devilray jacket at any time.
- You must wear the correct shoes to and during competitions. At no time can you wear flip-flops, sandals or slip on shoes.
- Under any circumstances are you allowed to wear jewelry during the competition day. This could result in your team being disqualified.
- All hair and makeup must be complete before entering the competition venue. No rollers or inappropriate attire.
- If you are not competing or have been dismissed from your team obligations, you may wear your warmup pants, a Devilray t-shirt, tennis shoes and jacket. You are still representing Devilray All Stars, and must present yourself in such a way.

- A: If the coach feels your daughter should be a flyer, she will be.

*** Each Cheerleader will be required to have a pair of black “swishy” pants, Black sports bra to be worn under your uniform top (males excluded, of course) a pair of white no show socks, one pair of Devilray shorts and shirt, and a pair of Nfinity shoes. We will offer the pants, socks and shoes through the gym on fitting day, you may purchase then or on your own.

Devilray Cheer Company accepts checks, money orders and all major credit cards. All correspondences to the Devilray Cheer Company must be made through the front office. Statements are mailed out periodically. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call the front office.

We have fundraisers available to those who are in financial need. Each year only 8-12% of families take advantage of gym sponsored fundraisers. It is possible to pay for an ENTIRE season on the fundraisers we offer. If you choose to do fundraisers the money made from the fundraiser will be taken off the back end of your monthly payments. If needed, please take advantage of these fundraisers so your child can participate.

If there is a financial problem, please talk to Daniel Szweda immediately. Your coach will not be able to advise you on these matters.

There will be no refunds made to anyone who is asked to leave the program or that quits a team. This includes all monthly fees and any monies paid into your DABC account.

- I realize that Devilray Allstars is a team orientated program and that a team is defined as a group organized to work together. I also realize that in order for a group to work together it is my responsibility to not only be supportive as a parent, but to also set a good example by demonstrating my willingness to work together with the team mom, coaching staff, team members, and other parents involved with the Devilray program.
- I understand the team I am put on will be decided by the coaching staff. I also realize the division that the team competes in will be based on what is best for that team and not the individual.
- I understand that my child may be a base, back spot, or flyer and that the coach of each team will pick which one of these positions my child will be. The coach's decision may change throughout the season based on performance, need, or preference. The decision is made by the coach and is not the decision of the parent.
- I understand that what role my son or daughter plays in the choreography of the routine is up to the coach. Just because your child has a certain skill does not mean they will use that skill in the routine or that they will always be in the front or back of the routine. It is up to the coach to make all decisions of choreography and what role your child will play in that choreography.
- As a parent I realize the importance of the team concept and that when there are mandatory practices, meetings, or competitions I will do everything in my power to make sure that my child will not only be there but that they will also be there on time.
- I realize that there will be two practices that my team is assigned and that they are mandatory practices. Therefore, I will not try to jeopardize my child's position on the team by allowing them to be involved in too many activities that limit them from missing their normal mandatory practices.
- I realize that the booster club and gym bill are my responsibility to pay and that the contract is binding and that every effort will be made to pay my bill on time.
- I realize that by signing this contract I am making a year long commitment to the Devilray All Star program. The focus should be on this year and not on future plans or other programs.
- I understand that every gym besides Devilrays is considered to be a competitor. Therefore, all training during the season needs to be done out of the Devilray gym. If I

am uncertain of becoming a Devilray and what that entails, I should not be trying out for the upcoming season.

- I realize that at anytime if my child is not keeping up their skills that someone else could possibly take my son or daughter's spot in the routine.
- I realize that tumbling class is considered to be a mandatory practice and that missing tumbling classes is the same as missing team practice.
- I realize that the team mom is not a paid position and that I will treat them respectfully and that if there is a problem I will talk to the coach in a prompt fashion about that problem.
- I understand that practices at the gym can be closed at anytime.
- I understand that bad mouthing coaches, parents, or children at the gym will not be tolerated.
- I understand that when I am at the gym or competition that I represent the gym and will act in a respectful manner that promotes the Devilray program.
- I understand that during practice is not the appropriate time to confront my coach with any issues related to my child. The best time would be to wait until I have properly calmed down and then setup a time to meet with my coach to discuss the situation.
- I understand that sitting in the chairs and being negative is only going to promote more negativity. I also understand that when my negativity starts to affect other gym members and their children that I have crossed the line and that it will not be tolerated.
- I understand what idle gossip and hearsay are, and will not participate in either one of them. I as a parent of the Devilray program will not make assumptions or react to a situation until I have talked to the parties involved to formulate the correct opinion.
- I understand that I should never step out on to the gym floor at any time unless deemed necessary by the coaching staff.
