Xtreme Rules and Regulations

Both, parents and athletes, must read the following rules and regulations carefully. All athletes will be required to adhere to the following:

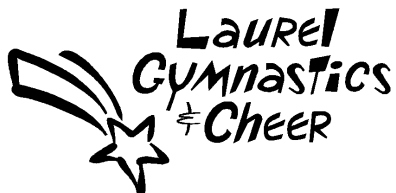
1. This contract is activated upon receipt and is valid through the completion of my membership on the squad.
2. Every effort should be made to attend all practice sessions, competitions, and any other scheduled team activities.
3. Coaches should be notified of all expected absences at least one week prior to the absence. Only excused absences are allowed. No absences are allowed two weeks before any team performance.
4. Practices always override private lessons in a scheduling conflict. The private lesson must be rescheduled.
5. Do not wear or bring my jewelry to practice. LGC and/or Xtreme All-Stars are not responsible for lost belongings.
6. All coaches' decisions on uniforms and competitions are final.
7. The coaching staff retains the right to allow a team member to be removed or a team member to be added at anytime.
8. The student will arrive to all competitions and teams functions in proper competition attire.
9. The student will follow the rules and regulations set by LGC and Xtreme All-Stars.

Xtreme Cheerleader Code of Conduct

1. Always come to practice, have a positive attitude, and put forth their best effort in the program.
2. Always set a positive example whether in or out of my uniform.
3. Always treat the fellow teammates, coaches, competitors, and coaches with respect.
4. Never lose composure or back-talk the coaching staff.
5. Always refrain from unnecessary conversation during practice.
6. Never allow anyone, including family members and friends, to distract you or interrupt you during practice session nor interrupt any other team practices.
7. Never act in a manner that jeopardizes the name and reputation of the LGC/Xtreme All-Stars.
8. Always understand that this is a one-year commitment and that the team is depending on them to fulfill my responsibilities to the team.
9. Always understand that failure to follow the above rule may result in removal from the team.

Xtreme Parent Code of Conduct

1. Always set up a time to meet with the coaches if you have any problems or questions. Parents should not take problems to other parents or gossip to others about a problem with the program, other students, the coach, or a coach's decision. This could lead to dismissal of your child from the program.
2. Always understand that every child is not going to be a flyer or on the front row of a formation. Every girl is important to the squad no matter where they are on the floor. We ask parents not to complain to coaches or others about a child's positioning on the floor.
3. Always resolve problems immediately if your child is involved in any matter of disrespect towards any members of the LGC staff or students.
4. Always put forth your best effort to get your child to practice on time and do not leave practice early.
5. Always understand that it is your responsibility to make arrangements for your child's travel, meal, and lodging for the scheduled competitions.
6. Always know the monetary impact of membership on this squad and ensure that you are financially able to make all payments. Ensure that all payments are made on a timely manner and do not risk the financial well-being of the squad. Meet all other financial obligations including travel expenses for competitions.



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Xtreme Financial Policy

1. The fees for the month of June and July are not required to be on bank draft.
2. Prepaid tuition is available at a discount but if you prefer monthly payments, you are required to complete a financial contract and pay by bank draft. You are required to submit a voided check in order for LGC to set up the monthly bank draft at the time you turn the financial contract in.
3. Monthly fees will be drafted on or a few days after the 15th of each month. If LGC is unable to draft the funds due to non-sufficient funds, incorrect, or incomplete information, fees will be applied (see contract).
4. In order to get the discounted membership rates, a financial contract must be received complete, including proper identification, and you must have a good payment history.
5. Failure to make timely payments can result in removal from the program.
6. Drop fees must be paid before a student can be released from contract. If drop fees and/or the remaining balance has not been paid in full, the student will not be released from the contract.
7. Prepaid Xtreme expenses are non-refundable.

Xtreme Bank Draft Policy

Laurel Gymnastics and Cheer offers automatic bank draft for all Xtreme students. A signed form with a voided check is required. The following applies to accounts with automatic bank draft:

Draft Dates: Accounts are drafted on or a few days after the 15th of each month for fees associated with regular monthly fees and competition fees if applicable.

Errors made to the account: If an error is made to the account and it is determined it was the error of LGC, LGC must be notified and proper records may be required for proof. If LGC finds the error, you will be notified immediately. LGC will then credit/debit your account to adjust the error.

Exiting out of the bank draft: Exiting out of the bank draft is automatic at the end of the season provided that your account does not have a balance and you are not taken other classes that are being drafted, in which the amount will be adjusted. You have the option of paying the balance of the account and canceling you bank draft. The original contract will be pulled for you to sign. This could take up to 10 business days to process. Non sufficient funds and closed accounts do cancel bank drafts and will only add extra fees to your account.

Non-sufficient funds: If any funds are returned as non-sufficient (or closed), a \$10 NSF fee will apply to your account. Also, if this return forces the account to be past due, you will also be charged a \$10 late fee. LGC will expect you to resolve these issues as soon a possible. If returned drafts become habitual, LGC has the right to ask you to prepay your tuition to retain membership.

Disputed Charges: Any disputed charges should be brought to the attention of LGC for proper review of the account. After LGC has reviewed the account, we will process any changes, if needed, to the check draft as required. Any bank draft stopped directly through the bank without the knowledge of LGC is subject to a \$40 stop payment fee plus the amount of the stopped payment if the bank draft made is a valid charge. LGC then reserves the right to cancel the bank draft and require full payment of the tuition. However, if it is determined that it was the error of LGC, the mistake will be corrected and no fees will apply. This does not pertain to those accounts that individuals requested cancellation less than 10 business days before a scheduled bank draft.
