Unexcused Absences

We have received your Absence Request Form for: **This is to notify you that your absence has been received and will be documented as an unexcused absence for each date that practice will be missed.**

ALL PRACTICES ARE MANDATORY BETWEEN: August 1, 2010 through April 15th, 2011 (this includes spring break).

As stated in the Team Handbook: **“All practices are mandatory. Any team member missing a practice for any reason other than extreme illness will go on record as an unexcused absence and possibly risk not participating in the competition. This will be at the discretion of the cheer director. Three missed practices is call for removal from the team.”**

Within 2 Weeks of a Competition:

Is Absence within two weeks of a Competition: **YES NO**
Upcoming Competition:

If yes, will the athlete be allowed to compete in the Upcoming Competition: **YES NO**
Reasoning: Yes, they will be allowed to compete under the expectation that no other practices will be missed leading up to the competition.

Hand-Washing prior to practice and before leaving practice should minimize some illnesses throughout the season.
