**Class Program Rules & Policies**

**Payment & Tuition** – Tuition for all classes is NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE. Currently, we accept cash, checks, and ACH payment (electronic payment directly from your account to ours) made out to “Ultimate Gymnastics, Inc. Any check returned from the bank is subject to a \$35.00 service charge. If tuition is not received by the first class in a session, your child will not be allowed to participate until payment is settled in full.

**Make-Up Policy** – Children who miss class are allowed to schedule up to (3) make-up classes during the 12-week session. Make-Ups must be scheduled at least one week in advance, through the office; and are based on available spots. If a make-up is missed, it cannot be re-scheduled. If for some reason you are going to miss your make-up, please call ahead and cancel so you do not lose your opportunity! Your other option is to attend open gym. We offer a make up week at the end of each session but you must sign up in advance.

**Changing Classes** – Parents may reschedule class times and days during the course of the 12-week session up to (1) time before incurring an additional fee. If a class time or day needs to be changed after the initial one time, a \$15.00 class change fee will be applied.

**Re-enrolling** – A student's class (day & time) slot will automatically be guaranteed into the next 12-week session until the end of the 1st week. After that time period, the slot will be dropped, and re-enrollment into that day and time will not be guaranteed.

**Dress Code** – For all classes, children should wear non-baggy, comfortable workout attire. For girls this might include a leotard (no stockings) or a t-shirt, shorts, and/or sweatpants. All hair

should be tied back away from the face. For boys, a t-shirt, shorts, and/or sweatpants would be acceptable. No child will be permitted to use the equipment wearing jeans, or any type of clothing with zippers, buttons, or snaps.

**Safety Policy** – All of the instructors and coaches at Ultimate Gymnastics are committed to being safety conscious and are regularly trained on proper progressions, procedures, and the latest spotting techniques. All activities are taught in a progressive manner, with the child mastering prerequisite skills before moving to more complex skills. However, the very nature of gymnastics carries the risk of injury, running from minor to serious. All parents should familiarize both themselves and their children with gym rules and policies, and abide by them. Ultimate Gymnastics, Inc. has the right to restrict any activities that we deem unsafe. All persons using the facility must have a signed and completed registration card on file. All participants must carry their own insurance, and are responsible for any bills incurred resulting from illness or injury. Any child who willfully disobeys their instructor or consistently demonstrates disregard for safety awareness (both to themselves and others involved in the gym) might be asked to leave the class, permanently. Disruptions might include instances of physical outbursts and/or verbal infractions. There will be no refunds offered in these situations.

**Weather & Closings** – In the event of a weather related closing, the gym will have a message on the answering machine stating whether or not the gym will be open and on our website calendar. We do not follow the Baltimore County School Schedule, nor do we follow their weather related closings. You should always check by calling the gym if you have any questions.

**Class Ratios** – The ratio of students to teachers will be 8:1\*. In certain classes, the ratios will be 6:1\*. \* During bring a friend week the ratio will exceed normal ratios.

**Spectators** – Spectators may and are encouraged to view from the waiting room. Please do not distract or coach your athlete from the windows. This can be dangerous and result in an injury to your athlete. Parents and/or guardians will not be allowed into the gym or on the equipment at any time.

**Valuables** – Please do not bring valuables to Ultimate Gymnastics. Ultimate Gymnastics is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

**Waiting Room** – The waiting room is available for you to wait for your athlete. Please do not allow your athlete and/or siblings to practice gymnastics, engage in horseplay, run, climb on the cubbies, or sit/stand on the tables. In addition, please do not leave your athletes/siblings left unattended before or after the course of the class. Athletes left unattended will be forced to call their parents or emergency contact and be sent home. Students may not be left alone in the lobby under the age of 13.

**Drop-off & Pick-Up** - Student should be dropped off on time and picked up on time. It is the parents responsibility to supervise the student before and after the class. Ultimate Gymnastics, Inc does not offer baby-sitting services.
